This property has been inspected and the following items were found to <u>NOT</u> comply with the Teton County Land Development Code (LDC) Sections 5-4-2 and 5-2.

Teton CountyLand Development Code Section 5-4-2 Riparian Buffers: Development is to have a setback of 100' from the National Wetland Inventory Boundary. Development is to have a setback of 50' from site specific wetland delineations approved by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The variance hearing to allow this work was continued on 11/12/2024 to 01/1/2024. No work has been approved and no permits have been issued as of 11/19/2024

The Teton County Land Development Code Chapter 5-2 Grading and Drainage, 5-2-1 Grading Standards B. Applicability 1. Grading for all developments (roads, driveways, building sites, landscaping, utilities, etc.) are required to meet the provisions of this Section. AND C. General Development Standards 1. A Grading and Erosion Control Permit is required prior to the commencement of all land disturbing activities, unless explicitly exempted.
