AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TETON COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL CLARITY AND MINOR GRAMMATICAL EDITS TO CHAPTERS 1, 3, 4, 5 AND 6 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE.

- 1) That the review criteria of a land development code amendment in LDC 4-4-F could be made.
- 2) That public comments received related to defensible space and heritage land splits will be included in future discussions on further code amendments.
