ITEM TITLE: **Action Item – Project Greenlight, Resolution 2024-1028**

Summary:

This item is for the Board to consider a resolution in support of U.S. Service members.

In order to show appreciation and support for those men and women who have served the United States as members of the armed forces, both throughout the United States, but especially in Teton County, Idaho, the Facilities Department requests that Teton County participate in Operation Green Light for the Second Year in a Row, and that the Board of County Commissioners sign Resolution 2024-1028 Supporting Operation Green Light for Veterans.

The Facilities Department plans to:

- Issue the attached resolution;
- Publish the attached press release in the Oct 30th edition of Teton Valley News (TVN)
- Shine green floodlights on all sides of the courthouse during the nights between November 4th and Veterans Day, November 11th;
- Wrap the front pedestrian lights leading up to the front steps and by the front steps with green gel filter paper.

Two flood lights will shine on the north and south sides, and one flood light will shine on each of the east and west sides of the courthouse.

Fiscal Impact:

The cost of the six flood lights and stakes totals \$121.34. The green gel filter paper cost \$37.98.
