ITEM TITLE: **Action Item – CHC Foundation Grant Agreement**

Summary:

Approve CHC Foundation Grant Agreement for Grooming Building

The County, through TVTAP and Grooming District efforts, was awarded grant money through the Idaho Parks & Recreation Off-Road Motor Vehicle grant program. The plan is to construct a storage and maintenance facility on the Buxton property next to the new SAR building.

TVTAP and the Grooming District's recent efforts were successful in being awarded an additional \$50,000 for this facility through the CHC Foundation. Attached is the agreement that has been presented for signature. This is a reimbursement grant that requires payment then reimbursement from the CHC Foundation.

This is a unique project in that Teton County will be the ultimate owner of the building. The BoCC has supported a long term agreement/lease for TVTAP and the Grooming District to occupy the facility. The building will be constructed on the northwest corner of our Buxton property, just north of the new SAR building.

Also attached is the Off Road Motor Vehicle Agreement that provides funding commitments from both IDPR and TVTAP/Grooming District. The Match will be a combination of in-kind and cash. The in-kind component includes demolition and removal of the existing building.

Fiscal Impact:

This is a reimbursement grant so the County will need to pay for services through a slush account and then get reimbursed through various grant programs. There is a significant amount of in kind and cash match being provided by TVTAP and the Grooming District. Once the County is reimbursed for expenses, there should be zero cost incurred by the County.
