Public Works:

Gravel Request for Wylie Lane – Bill Lofholm has requested access to County gravel material for improving Wylie Lane. Wylie Lane is a 1 mile County Road located off of N8000W. The dead end road provides access to one residence. Mr. Lofholm would like to make improvements on Wylie Lane. Mr. Lofholm have been allowed to use County material for improvements in the past.

Gravel Pit Opportunity- Landowner for RP04N45E354650 has approached Public Works about the possibility of a gravel pit located in the south end of Teton Valley.

Speed Limits – There has been some heightened interest in County speed limits lately. I want to take that opportunity to begin discussing how we can develop a defensible policy for reasonable speed limits throughout the County.
