ITEM TITLE: **ACTION ITEM: DOWNTOWN DRIGGS ASSOCIATION - SHAKESPEARE IN THE PARK**

The Downtown Driggs Association (DDA) has confirmation from the Montana Shakespeare in the Parks team regarding their 2024 Driggs performance and would love to hold the event at the Teton County Courthouse Lawn again this year. **DDA have formal approval from the Tributary HOA to hold the event on the lawn.** Ulla at Tributary explained that a land swap may or may not have an impact on the availability of the lawn for this event.

Here are the details:

When: Sunday, July 28, 5:30-8:00pm

What: Vaudeville Skits performed by the local nonprofit ACT Foundation from 5:30-6pm followed by Shakespeare in the Parks performance of Hamlet from 6-8pm

Where: Teton County Courthouse Lawn

Est. Attendance - 400

Food Truck: Captain Ron's Barbecue

DDA Beer/Wine Tent Liquor License - we will secure a liquor license through the state/city/county. DDA will sell donated beer from Citizen 33 and wine purchased from a local distributor. We will carefully check all ID's, our volunteers are trained in this.

Teton County Fire & Rescue - will be on-call (as with Music on Main)

Safety/Traffic Flow: Large traffic cones will block off the road directly in front of the courthouse, where attendees will access the food truck/beer and wine tent/port-a-potties. Large attendance levels are not expected, so don't envision the need for Idaho Traffic Safety signs rerouting drivers.

Restrooms: DDA will reserve three port-a-potties (one handicapped accessible) secured for the event with Parker Septic Tank Services.

Trash: RAD Recycling will provide trash and recycling receptacles for the event

Sprinklers: We need to confirm when sprinklers are scheduled to go off, etc.

The Shakespeare crew (11 total performers) will arrive early, around 1:00 pm, to set up the stage. We expect folks to start arriving as early as 5:00pm to stake out a space on the lawn with blankets or chairs.

The performance ends around 8:00pm, after which the stage will be uninstalled.
