Teton County has required the preparation of a Water Quality Impact Analysis (NP Evaluation) for the above-referenced proposed development pursuant to the Teton County Subdivision Ordinance. Teton County has requested DEQ review the NP Evaluation. This letter contains DEQ's comments and recommendations regarding the NP Evaluation. This letter does not constitute an approval, license, permit, or any other form of authorization required by law. This letter reflects DEQ's opinion, based upon the information and analysis in the July 2023 NP Evaluation regarding whether discharges from the wastewater systems for the proposed development will comply with the Idaho Ground Water Quality Rule and Idaho Water Quality Standards.

After our review of the NP Evaluation, DEQ concurs with the findings of the report. The NP Evaluation has indicated that there will not be any significant degradation to the groundwater or surface water from the individual subsurface disposal systems if constructed per the current *Individual Subsurface Sewage Disposal Rules*, IDAPA 58.01.03 and the *Technical Guidance Manual*.
