Current Projects

On March 5th for our Local Emergency Planning Committee meeting we had three representatives from the Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency and one representative from the Idaho fusion center brief us on the current cyber, physical, election, and financial threats that they see. Because of the weather situation, it had to be a zoom meeting.

We have completed the firewall transition and have most of the connections to outside agencies rebuilt. The title companies are all connected, and we are working with the State and other partners to reconfigure their access in a more secure way.

Future Projects

On March 18th through the 22nd some of our IT staff and many of our regional partners will be attending a Network Defense Class that I requested about a year ago. It will be the first time that the National Cybersecurity Preparedness Consortium has delivered a class in Idaho. The consortium is comprised of universities across the Country that are working with the Department of Homeland Security to provide no cost cybersecurity training to public agencies.

On March 14th we will be hosting our response partners from Teton County Wyoming in a quarterly meeting that will include a communications exercise that we will be leading.
