DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The project consists of site clearing, construction of pad to receive a pre-engineered metal building, installation of utilities, site grading, design and installation of concrete foundation system, and slab. Design, furnishing and erection of pre-engineered metal building as identified in the Contract Documents. Bid alternates are identified with in the Contract Documents for additional interior framing work and finish work, including HVAC, plumbing and electrical, as well as work associated with an existing structure on the site.

ESTIMATED COST OF BASE BID CONSTRUCTION: \$500,000.

BID BOND: A bid bond equal to 5% of the amount bid must accompany the bid proposal (see instruction to bidders).

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: Public Works Contractor's License for the State of Idaho is required to bid this project (see instruction to bidders and general conditions for further instructions to bidders).

Each bidder shall comply with all fair labor practices and all applicable statutes of the State of Idaho.

Each bid shall be accompanied by lawful monies of the United States of America with a Cashiers Check, Certified Check, Bank Money Order or Bank Draft, in any case, drawn and issued by a National Banking Association located in the State of Idaho or a bid bond or bonds executed by a Surety Corporation authorized to do business in the State of Idaho in the amount of not less than Five (5%) percent of the total bid,

made payable to the owner as a guarantee of complete compliance with the contract documents. The successful bidder shall furnish the certificate of insurance, performance bond, and material and labor payment bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract. Should the bidder fail or refuse to enter into the contract to furnish the 100% bonds, the bid bond of the accepted bidder shall be forfeited to the owner.

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities and accept any bids which it deems advantageous.
